## Match background

---

Victory in Greece has put Bayern München in a strong position in Group E as they welcome AEK Athens on matchday four looking for their first home victory of this season's UEFA Champions League.

- Bayern stretched their unbeaten run against Greek clubs to ten games with a 2-0 success at AEK on 23 October thanks to two goals in three second-half minutes from Javi Martínez and Robert Lewandowski.
- That left the German champions on seven points, joint top of the section with Ajax – while AEK have lost all three matches. Bayern will therefore be through with a win if Benfica lose at Ajax in the section's other matchday four contest; AEK will be unable to finish in the top two if they lose, or if they draw and Ajax avoid defeat.

### Form guide

#### Bayern

- Having opened Group E with a 2-0 win at Benfica, Bayern were held to a 1-1 draw by Ajax in their first home game.
- The Ajax draw made it three European home games without a win for Bayern. They won their first four in 2017/18, before drawing with Sevilla in the quarter-final second leg and losing to Real Madrid in the semi-final first leg.
- Champions of Germany for a record 28th time last season – with a landmark sixth successive Bundesliga title – Bayern are in the group stage for the 22nd time.
- The Munich club have reached the UEFA Champions League quarter-finals or better in each of the last seven seasons. They last failed to progress from the initial group section in 2002/03, although they missed out altogether on the UEFA Champions League in 2007/08.
- For the second year in a row Bayern's campaign was ended by Real Madrid in 2017/18, via a 4-3 aggregate semi-final defeat.
- Bayern have never lost to a Greek club, home or away (W8 D2), and have won four of out five at home – most recently a 4-0 success against Olympiacos in the 2015/16 group stage in which Robert Lewandowski, Thomas Müller and Kingsley Coman all scored. Bayern have scored 18 goals without reply in those five matches.
- The German side have kept clean sheets in their last seven matches with Greek opponents, scoring 15 goals across the four most recent contests.

#### AEK Athens

- Beaten 3-0 at Ajax in their first fixture, AEK went down 3-2 at home to Benfica on matchday two. The home defeat by Bayern made it three successive European losses – the Greek side have not lost four in a row in Europe since autumn 2011.
- AEK were 14 European games unbeaten (W4 D10), home and away, before the loss at Ajax. That result also ended a seven-match undefeated run away from home (W2 D5).
- AEK are in the group stage for the fifth time – and the first since 2006/07.
- All four of the Athens club's previous UEFA Champions League group campaigns have ended at that stage.
- Greek champions for the 12th time in 2017/18 – their first championship success since 1994 – AEK entered this season's UEFA Champions League in the third qualifying round, where they defeated Celtic 3-2 on aggregate (1-1 away, 2-1 home) to reach the play-offs. There they overcame Hungarian club Vidi 3-2 over two games (2-1 away, 1-1 home).
- The home win against Celtic ended AEK's run of eight successive draws in European competition.
- Last season AEK lost to CSKA Moskva in the UEFA Champions League third qualifying round and moved into the UEFA Europa League, where they were eliminated by Dynamo Kyiv in the round of 32 despite avoiding defeat in all ten of their matches in the competition (W2 D8).
- AEK have won only two of their ten European fixtures against German clubs (D1 L7), both at home. They lost their first three games in Germany although the most recent, at Bayer Leverkusen in the 2000/01 UEFA Cup third round, ended in a remarkable 4-4 draw.

### Latest news

## Bayern

- Robert Lewandowski's next appearance in UEFA club competition will be his 100th.
- James Rodríguez is one game away from 50 in the UEFA Champions League, group stage to final.
- Bayern had won four games in a row, all away from home, before being held 1-1 in Munich by Freiburg on Saturday to slip four points behind Bundesliga leaders Borussia Dortmund.
- Before that sequence of victories Bayern had been four competitive matches without a win – their worst run since April 2017.
- The Munich club have not won in four home matches (D3 L1), their longest run without a success in front of their own fans since four straight draws in November/December 2001.
- The 3-0 home defeat against Borussia Mönchengladbach on 6 October was Bayern's biggest reverse since a 3-0 loss at Paris Saint-Germain on matchday two of the 2017/18 UEFA Champions League.
- Bayern won 2-1 at fourth division Rödinghausen in the German Cup second round on 30 October, Sandro Wagner scoring his first goal of the season. Thomas Müller was on target with a penalty, Renato Sanches missed one.
- Three days earlier Thiago Alcántara had sealed Bayern's 2-1 Bundesliga success at Mainz with his first goal of the season.
- Lewandowski has scored eleven goals in 14 appearances for Bayern this season.
- Mats Hummels (muscular problems), Jérôme Boateng, James Rodríguez (both illness) and Arjen Robben (back) all missed the Rödinghausen game; the last three returned against Freiburg with Hummels an unused substitute.
- Thiago was substituted at Rödinghausen with an ankle injury and is expected to be out for several weeks.
- Corentin Tolisso, part of the victorious France squad at this summer's FIFA World Cup, suffered torn cruciate ligaments in his right knee in the 3-1 win against Bayer Leverkusen on 15 September and will be absent for several months.
- Kingsley Coman suffered an ankle injury that required surgery in a 3-1 win against Hoffenheim on 24 August, the first day of the Bundesliga season.
- Niko Kovač claimed silverware in his first competitive game as Bayern coach with a 5-0 defeat of his former club Eintracht Frankfurt in the German Super Cup on 12 August – the third year in a row the Munich club have won the competition following three successive defeats.

## AEK Athens

- AEK's 25-match unbeaten run (W20 D5) in the Greek Superleague was ended by a 2-0 loss at PAOK on 23 September – their previous defeat was a 1-0 home reverse against Atromitos on 23 October 2017. They have picked up three wins and two draws since, sharing a goalless stalemate with Panathinaikos on Saturday.
- AEK have kept three successive clean sheets in all competitions and four in their last five games, and have lost only one of their last seven matches (W4 D2) – the matchday three defeat by Bayern.
- The Athens club made it two wins in as many games in the Greek Cup group stage with a 4-0 success at Apollon Larissa on 31 October.
- Lucas Boyé marked his first AEK start with the opening goal in a 4-0 victory against Aris on 28 October and also provided the assist to Marko Livaja for the fourth goal.
- The victory against Aris was Marinou Ouzounidis's 100th Super League win as a coach.
- Tasos Bakasetas suffered a hip injury in training on 26 October.
- Hélder Lopes underwent surgery after tearing the anterior cruciate ligament of his left knee against OFI Crete on 29 September. He is expected back to action in spring 2019.
- Erik Morán sustained a left ankle strain during the league encounter against Apollon Smyrni on 20 October, returning to training ten days later.

## Head coach

### Niko Kovač

---

**Date of birth:** 15 October 1971

**Nationality:** Croatian

**Playing career:** Hertha Zehlendorf, Hertha Berlin (twice), Bayer Leverkusen, Hamburg, Bayern München, Salzburg

**Coaching career:** Croatia Under-21, Croatia, Eintracht Frankfurt, Bayern München

- Born in Berlin to parents hailing from Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kovač began his career at local side Hertha Zehlendorf before earning a move to 2. Bundesliga side Hertha Berlin in 1991. A defensive midfielder, he then joined Leverkusen, playing alongside younger brother Robert for the first time.
- Signed for Hamburg in 1999 but was reunited with Robert when the pair were snapped up by Bayern two years later. Won a league and cup double in 2002/03 yet struggled to tie down a starting spot and returned to Hertha in 2003, subsequently ending his playing days with Salzburg.
- Collected his first Croatia cap in 1996 and featured in 1998 FIFA World Cup qualifying, only for injury to rule him out of the finals. Ever-present at the 2002 World Cup and UEFA EURO 2004, he also featured in the 2006 World Cup and UEFA EURO 2008, retiring in 2009 with 83 caps and 14 international goals.
- Quickly turned to coaching, first overseeing Salzburg's youth side and then working as a first-team assistant. Left Salzburg in 2012 and took charge, assisted by brother Robert, of Croatia's U21 squad in January 2013 before stepping up to the senior side that October following Igor Štimac's resignation. Took Croatia to the 2014 World Cup via the play-offs but was unable to guide his side into the knockout rounds and dismissed in September 2015.
- Resurfaced at Eintracht in March 2016, guiding the club to Bundesliga survival that year and mid-table safety, plus the German Cup final, in 2016/17. Oversaw an eighth-place finish the following campaign and having been announced as the new Bayern coach in April 2018, Kovač bowed out at Eintracht by winning the club's first trophy since 1988 with victory in the German Cup final – against Bayern.

### Marinos Ouzounidis

---

**Date of birth:** 10 October 1968

**Nationality:** Greek

**Playing career:** Apollon Kalamaria, Xanthi, Panathinaikos, Le Havre, Paniliakos, APOEL

**Coaching career:** Kappadokes Alexandroupolis, Xanthi (assistant), APOEL, AEL Larissa, Iraklis, Xanthi, Platania, Ergotelis, Panionios, Panathinaikos, AEK Athens

- Started out in the youth ranks of home-town club Ethnikos Alexandroupolis, a year at Apollon Kalamaria preceding a move to Xanthi aged 19. There Ouzounidis carved a reputation as a centre-back with an eye for goal – 16 in 140 matches – earning a 1992 move to Panathinaikos.
- Won two league titles and three Greek Cups over five successful years with the Greens, and was the cornerstone of the defence that reached the 1995/96 UEFA Champions League semi-finals, before a two-year stint in France at Le Havre.
- Returned to Greece in 1999 for two seasons with Paniliakos, switching to APOEL in 2001. The Cypriot league title followed 12 months later, Ouzounidis deciding to hang up his boots in 2003 aged 34 having won 50 caps for the Greece national team.
- Moved into coaching almost immediately, once again kicking off his career in his native Alexandroupoli at lower-league Kappadokes. He got his first job as head coach in 2006 at APOEL, leading them to the Cypriot league title in his first season.
- Took over at AEL Larissa for two years from 2008 and, after spells at Iraklis, Xanthi, Platania and Ergotelis, landed the Panionios job in December 2014. Positive results added to his growing coaching reputation, paving the way for Ouzounidis to take over Panathinaikos in December 2016. He joined AEK in the summer of 2018 and led them to wins against Celtic and Vidi and into the UEFA Champions League group stage for the first time in 12 years.
